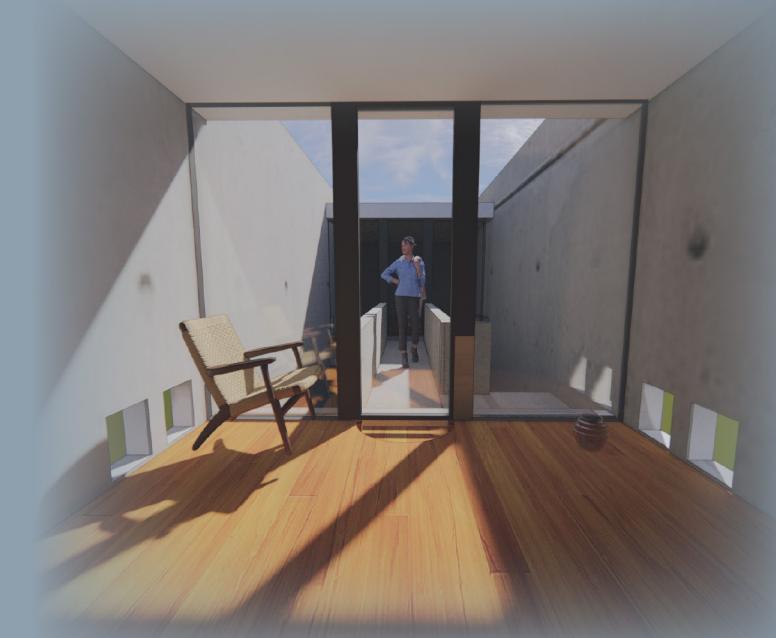
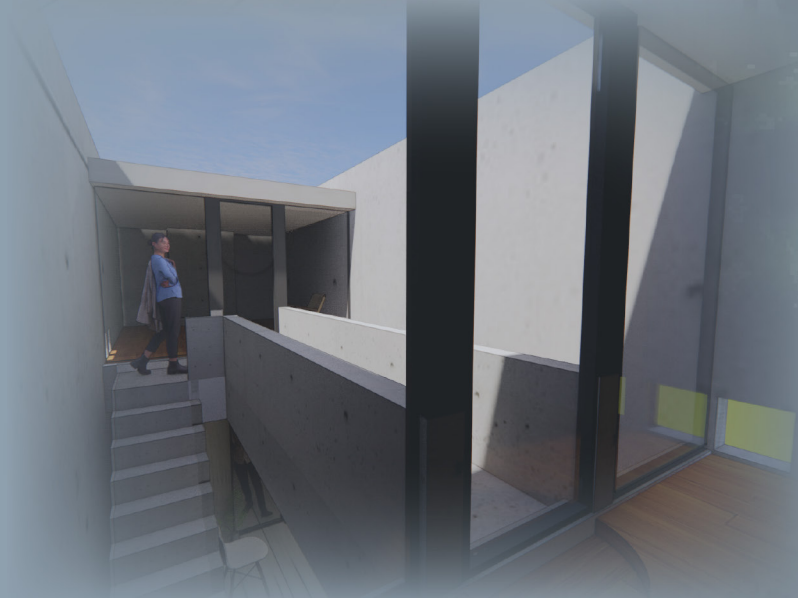
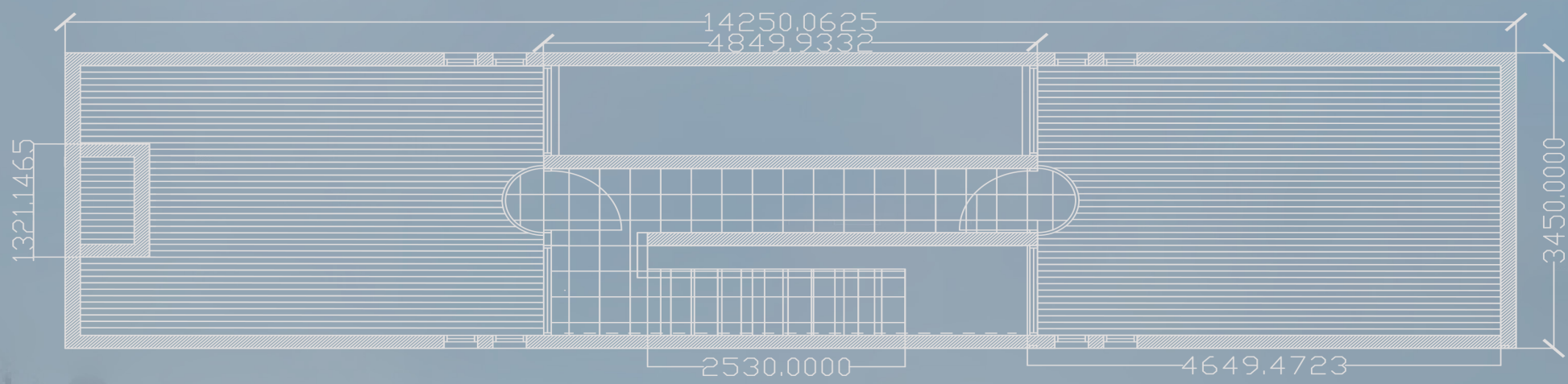


Azuma House
